In class #2 they will go over ground poles on the outside lines once around the ring.</p> <p>WalkTrot (WT) In Ring 3 will w/t their horse on the rail w/o assistance. One at a time will trot over the outside 12" cross rails.</p>	<p>Young Entry (YE) Will canter spread out on the rail for one at a time their 12" cross rails</p> <p>Schooling Prior to Show and @ lunch</p> <p>Novice Will canter on the rail as a group. The course consists of 18" vertical and diagonal lines of which they are encouraged to canter.</p>	<p>Low Hunter (2' Jumps) Schooling Hunter (2'3" - 2'6") Special Hunter (2'9" - 3') Flat class will canter as a group.
